# **Recipes by Dorothy Oliveira**

## Arroz de Marisco

### (Seafood Rice)

#### **Ingredients:**

1 onion
4 cloves garlic minced
4 tbls olive oil
4 tomatoes peeled (1 can 14oz)
1-1/2 lbs seafood (combination of fish, scallops, shrimp, clams, crab or any combination of seafood you like)
1/2 cup white wine
1 cup rice
1 cube fish bouillon
Optional: Hot sauce, red pepper, chopped cilantro

#### Method:

Sauté onion and garlic in olive oil. Add tomatoes. Add hot sauce or red pepper and salt to taste. Simmer for 10 minutes. Add seafood mixture. Simmer 15 minutes covered and then remove all the seafood. In the same pot add 1 cube fish bouillon and 3 cups hot water and boil. When it starts to boil add 1 cup rice. Stir. Let boil for 10 minutes covered and then another 2 minutes uncovered. Turn off fire and add seafood ingredients. Top with chopped cilantro and serve.

## **Bebinca de Leite**

#### (Coconut Milk Custard)

#### **Ingredients:**

- 1 can condense milk
- 2 cans coconut milk
- 2-1/2 cups water
- 1 cup cornstarch
- 2 tlbs butter

#### Method:

Mix cornstarch with water. In saucepan bring almost to a boil coconut milk, condense milk and butter. Slowly pour cornstarch mixture stirring all the time until it thickens. Pour into mould and cool overnight.

## Portuguese Immigrant Week March 10 - 17, 2018

In 1969, then Governor Ronald Reagan proclaimed Portuguese Immigrant Week in California in honor of the Portuguese immigrants in California which has been celebrated on the second week of March every year since. This year's celebration took place from March  $10^{\text{th}} - 17^{\text{th}}$ .

To welcome the 2018 Portuguese Immigrant Week, many gathered in front of the Portuguese Immigrant Monument in Root Park, San Leandro on March 10<sup>th</sup> to attend the wreath ceremony commemorating the journey of Portuguese settlers

who left everything behind to start a new life in the new world. This white marble monument standing 20ft high was a gift to the City of San Leandro in 1964 from the former Portuguese Union of the State of California (UPEC), now renamed as the Portuguese Fraternal Society of America (PFSA).

To honor the event, present was our Consul General of Portugal in



San Francisco, Dra. Maria João Lopes-Cardoso, along with other dignitaries and members of our Macanese community. The Portuguese and American National Anthems were performed beautifully by Filarmonica Artista Amadora de San Leandro.





The wreath ceremony was followed by a book presentation at the J.A. Freitas Library. 
